ELIGIBILITY MASTER/ ADVANCED PLAYER: Any player listed on any state or national **Advanced/Masters** lists, incl. APA, VNEA, ACS and BCAPL...or "Known Ability" with skills commensurate with players on these lists. Professional players are not eligible.

OPEN PLAYER: Any player who does not meet "Advanced Player" guidelines and who averages an "8" or "9" in a league that uses the 10- point scoring system or the equivalent if using other scoring systems - an average or above-average player in most leagues.

STANDARD PLAYER: Any player who does not meet "Open or Advanced Player" guidelines and who averages a "7" or below in a league that uses the 10-point scoring system or the equivalent if using other scoring systems – a below-average player in most leagues.
